

## Selected for the highest-rated A-List under CDP 2023 Climate Change

The only construction company in A-List for the sixth consecutive year

Toda Corporation (headquarters: Chuo-ku, Tokyo; President: Otani Seisuke) was selected for CDP 2023 Climate Change A-List by CDP (Head Office: London), an international non-governmental organization conducting environmental assessment. It was recognized as a leading global company in its activities and disclosures about climate change.

In 2023, 346 companies worldwide and 109 companies including us in Japan, were selected as Climate Change A-List. We are an A-listed climate change company for the sixth consecutive years since 2018. This achievement marks our company as the only general contractor and one of just 9 companies in Japan.

### 【Toda Corporation Initiatives】

We aim to reduce greenhouse gas emissions in our business activities to virtually zero by 2050 and are tackling climate change throughout our supply chain. Buildings are utilized over extended periods, necessitating considerations throughout their life cycle. Therefore, measures are required at various life cycle stages, such as using renewable energy in construction, implementing energy-efficient designs, and adopting environmentally friendly-materials with low greenhouse gas emissions during manufacturing<sup>※1</sup>.

Regarding environmentally friendly materials, it is essential to quantitatively understand environmental data, including greenhouse gas emissions, using the EPD<sup>※2</sup> mechanism. In April 2023, we obtained EPD for the environmentally friendly concrete “Slagrete<sup>®</sup> 70”, which uses pulverized blast furnace slag powder<sup>※3</sup>. We will continue tackling climate change by contributing to expanding EPD-certified products and having customers adopt these products.

### 【About CDP】

CDP is a global non-governmental organization (NGO) established in 2000 and operates a global environmental disclosure system. In 2023, over 24,000 organizations, comprising more than 23,000 companies and over 1,100 municipalities disclosed environmental information through CDP. Collectively, these organizations represent two-thirds of global market capitalization. CDP scores are widely used to drive investment and procurement decisions toward a sustainable and resilient economy.
